"Per bend sinister, azure and argent, a lightning bolt or, the first charged with a canopy of the second, the second charged with a compass rose the proper barbs East and West party per fess, North and South party per fess, North and South party per pale, countercoloured gules and the third, subordinate barbs vert, the shield fimbriated of the third and a bordure, dexter base to sinister base, of the second, with sable inscription."

Significance

The Lightning Bolt represents the communication aspect of the Combat Control Team and also portrays the quick reaction of the teams to meet a world-wide challenge.

The Parachute Canopy is indicative of the Primary form of deployment.

The Compass Rose represents the world-wide deployments of the teams and the ability to navigate by land.

The Blue Background represents Combat Control's air mission as a proud member of the United States Air Force.

The Silver Background is a token of our reliance on Aircraft.




